## Israel wins Photo of the year at the Pepsi ICC Development Awards

This photo taken during the 2012 season by local club players, David Harris and Charlton Book has won the ICC European Pepsi Photo of the Year and will now go forward to represent Europe in this category in the Global Awards, later in 2013, hosted in Dubai.

The photo shows cricket carrying on as normal during an official [20-20](#) game in Lod, Israel, despite a bush fire breaking out next to the ground. The game was eventually halted for

five minutes as smoke made visibility too poor. The local fire brigade doused the flames and play resumed. The photo has appeared in a number of UK cricket magazines and received 20 000 hits in the space of 30 seconds on the Cricinfo website.

## ***Yaniv Razpurker selected ICA Player of the Year***

The ICA Board decided to approve the recommendation of management and coaching staff, selecting Yaniv Razpurker as 2012 Player of the Year. Apart from another successful season on the domestic scene with his club Neve Yonatan with both bat and ball.

Yaniv was one of the outstanding players for Israel at the European Championships in Corfu in September. His innings of 25 off just 10 balls was instrumental in Israel's win over Portugal, against Luxembourg he settled a nervous chase with 19\*, and against Malta contributed 17 in a low scoring game. A recurring hamstring injury unfortunately ruled him out of the remainder of the tournament, undoubtedly a contributing factor in Israel's eventual disappointing semi-final defeat against the Isle of Man.

Apart from his performances, Razpurker, a product of Israel's youth development program who represented Israel through the age groups, continues to set the standard in sportsmanship and conduct both on and off the field, making him one of the most well-liked and respected cricketers in the country.



## ***Lions Lod clinch Division 1 title while Petach Tikva earn promotion***

Lions Lod, so dominant over recent years, regained the Dudi Silbowitz trophy, after a three year wait, winning the Division 1 title. Lions, having won eight of their nine games through the season were duly crowned Champions.

On the other end of the table, Beersheva 'A', who were promoted to division 1 in 2011, will play their cricket in division 2 in 2013 after suffering relegation with one win in nine games.



Petach Tikva earned promotion to the 1st Division after a remarkable season winning 6 out of their 7 matches while Young Sri Lanka, having finished 2nd, missed out on promotion after losing the playoff match with Ra'anana 1 who will remain in Division 1 for the 2013 season.

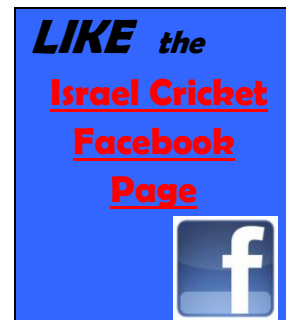
## Night Action Cricket League

20 Years of India-Israel Diplomatic Relations

The tournament was played in December 2012 with twelve teams participating in a T20 league and knock out tournament. Ambassador of India to Israel Mr. Jaideep Sarkar inaugurated the tournament along with Mr. Stanley Perlman, President of the ICA.

Lions Lod (185/6 in 20 overs) defeated Young Ashdod (164/6 in 20 overs) in an exciting final, while Qiryat Gat beat Beersheva in the 3rd/4th place match. Yaniv Razpurker was crowned best batsmen of the tournament while Ronen Waskar won the best bowler.
