The Norwich Union National Cricket League is just beyond the halfway stage and there are still a myriad of possibilities as far as the championships, promotion and relegation are concerned

Crowds have flocked to cricket FCB grounds around the country to witness the excitement of the one-day competition and savour the talents of the world-class players on show

Four teams are still in with a chance of clinching the Norwich Union NCL Division One title, with Worcestershire Royals currently in pole position, but Somerset Sabres, Gloucestershire Gladiators and Leicestershire Foxes are all within four points of the leaders

At the other end of the table, former oneday kings Lancashire Lightning are in the unfamiliar position of bottom spot, along with Kent Spitfires on a meagre 12 points. Phoenix, Northamptonshire Yorkshire Steelbacks and Sussex Sharks will also have

their work cut out to avoid being relegated to Division Two next season.

Surrey Lions appear to have already wrapped up promotion to the upper-tier for next season, and remain impressively unbeaten after 10 games. But Nottinghamshire Outlaws will not have given up on the title, while Middlesex

Crusaders and Warwickshire Bears also have a slim chance if the Lions were to slip badly.

Glamorgan Dragons and Essex Eagles will both harbour hopes of a top-three finish which will see them in the upper echelon of the Norwich Union National Cricket League.


At the foot of the table, either Derbyshire Scorpions or Hampshire Hawks look set for the wooden spoon at the end of the season, with both teams having won just one match all







Season So Far

orcestershire Royals' pre-season capture of Australian pace star Glenn McGrath highlighted the county's desire for silverware this season and they have simply been brilliant in the first half of the Norwich Union National League Division One campaign.

McGrath was always expected to take wickets in his first English season, but he has been especially effective with the white ball on seaming, early-season pitches. His 22-wicket haul at an average of just 6.36 helped to take the Royals to the summit of the league with six victories in succession despite an opening-game defeat against

Yorkshire Phoenix.

But the hallmark of a winning side is their ability to hit back with the right result, and they achieved it with a nine-run revenge win against Phoenix at Headingley.

The victory kick-started their awesome run which included notable back-to-back wins over one-day specialists Lancashire Lightning and Gloucestershire Gladiators.

England one-day player Vikram Solanki struck an unbeaten 59 against Lightning before that man McGrath picked up three wickets for just 11 runs in a 12-run victory.

Second-placed Somerset Sabres could do little to prevent Royals' stay at the top as Graeme Hick struck a magnificent century to steer his side to 222 from 45 overs. Kabir Ali then helped his side to a four-run success after producing an impressive spell of bowling, claiming three wickets for 44 runs with his medium pace.

Royals produced a disappointing showing in their latest game, a three-wicket defeat against Gladiators. But they have already shown that they have what it takes to last the distance this season. And if Hick, Solanki and McGrath can continue to fire - the Royals look to have both the talent and the substance to march to the Division One title.

Season So Far

he Sabres are in with a brilliant chance of winning the Norwich Union National Cricket League as they move into the second half of the season.

Jamie Cox's side are within two points of leaders Worcestershire Royals and with seven games to go the championship is wide open.

It has been an impressive first season in the top division for the West Country side, who finished runners-up in the Second Division last season.

As ever, Cox has been vital to their success, scoring some useful runs at the top of the order but he has by no means hogged

That largely belongs to England's latest

recruit Marcus Trescothick, who has had a fine season to date.

The opener is the top Englishman in the division batting averages, second only to the Sussex Sharks' Michael Bevan, a man widely regarded as the best one-day batsman in the world.

Trescothick's impressive statistics were certainly one of the main factors in the Sabres' fine start to their campaign.

The Sharks, Gloucestershire Gladiators, Northamptonshire Steelbacks and Kent Spitfires all fell victim to the Taunton-based club in the opening weeks.

They may only have won two of their subsequent five matches, but with the Royals' stunning start to the season coming to an end with two recent defeats, they are very much still in the hunt.

Welshman Steffan Jones has been the key performer with the ball for the secondplaced side.

The 26-year-old is the side's leading wicket-taker with 21, including a best of 4 for 21, and is well placed among the division's top bowlers.

Next up for the Sabres are the Yorkshire Phoenix, who they beat by two runs in their previous game. The third-placed Gladiators follow at Bristol for a game that could have a significant baring on the final shape of the table.

loucestershire Gladiators' pedigree as a one-day side is undoubted. The side claimed silverware in both oneday competitions last season - and one already this year - and now coach John Bracewell is trying to coax his side into repeating those heroics as the Norwich Union National Cricket League Division One moves towards an exhilarating finale.

The Gladiators are perfectly placed to strike for the championship, and Bracewell will be setting his sights on a total of a dozen victories this season. That does not leave much room to play with for captain Mark Alleyne.

The Gladiators' 10 outings this year have

resulted in six wins and four defeats. And if 12 wins are to be clocked up by September, Gloucestershire Gladiators will surely claim the Norwich Union National Cricket League Division One title. So when Jamie Cox's second-placed Somerset Sabres make the short journey to Bristol for the Gladiators' next match, the home side will be desperate to make it three wins on the bounce.

That could hoist them to the top of the league, and if wicketkeeper Jack Russell proves to be as useful with his bat as he was in the five-wicket victory over Kent Spitfires, the signs are good.

Russell smashed 55 runs from 60 balls to shore up the innings after a batch of cheap

wickets threaten to disrupt the side's dreams of more silverware glory. That was a very useful victory as the Spitfires - who are having a poor season at the wrong end of the table - posted 199 runs on the board.

If Gloucestershire Gladiators are to claim first spot, they must be sure to avoid a repeat of the form that blighted three weeks in May. Then, three successive defeats in three weeks, against Yorkshire Phoenix, Kent Spitfires and Worcestershire Royals, sent jitters through the camp. But they bounced back and now have 24 points in the kitty and 24 more to play for.

Season So Far

eicestershire Foxes are perfectly placed for an assault on the Norwich Union National League Division One title with seven games of the season remaining.

Captain Vince Wells has seen his side beaten just twice so far this summer, and they are just four points adrift of league leaders Worcestershire Royals, with 28 points still to play for. And with Royals due to visit Grace Road in the penultimate match of the season, the scene is already being set for a potential championship-decider.

Foxes made an unusual start to the season, with their encounters against Sussex Sharks and Lancashire Lightning both ending in ties, with the scores level after 45 overs on both occasions. But they followed up their unbeaten start to the season with

back-to-back three-wicket victories over Kent Spitfires and Yorkshire Phoenix. Sussex Sharks were the first side to get the better of the Foxes in the Norwich Union competition, recording an 11-run victory at Horsham in June. But Wells' men bounced back well, with a 38-run success over a strong Gloucestershire Gladiators side.

Their eagerly-awaited first encounter with Worcestershire Royals fell victim to the weather, although Foxes looked well-placed after reducing Royals to 108-8 after 38 overs. Northamptonshire Steelbacks inflicted a second defeat on Foxes, but Lightning were sent home to Lancashire with their tails between their legs after a seven-wicket drubbing.

Ben Smith and Aftab Habib have been the

star performers with the bat for Foxes, with both players averaging over 45 at this stage of the season. Smith scored an impressive 90 in the tied match against Lightning at Old Trafford, before hitting an unbeaten 88 in the Headingley victory over Phoenix.

Habib has saved his best performances for the home crowd, with 70 against Steelbacks and 63 against Lightning at Grace Road. Former England all-rounder Chris Lewis is the leading wicket-taker, with 12 victims, while the spin of India's Anil Kumble has helped him pick up 11 wickets. Foxes next three matches are all against teams below them in the table, before they face a testing run-in with matches against Gladiators, Royals and a double-date with Somerset Sabres.
