

● FOXES EYE TENTH WIN OF THE SEASON

Leicestershire Foxes' seemingly unstoppable march towards their first league title in 24 years could gain further momentum as they take on Norwich Union League Division One strugglers Somerset Sabres.

Vince Wells' men extended the breathing space between themselves and second-placed Kent Spitfires, who boast Aussie all-rounder Andrew Symonds, to eight points with a 14-run victory over Matthew Fleming's side at Canterbury last time out.

A further victory against the Sabres would leave the chasing pack with a lot of work to do as the season enters its final month.

For the Sabres, relegation is a serious threat but ending the Foxes' nine-game winning streak would give them every chance of ensuring First Division survival.

Sabres skipper Jamie Cox will certainly hope fellow opener Peter Bowler can match the kind of form he showed in his side's defeat by Nottinghamshire Outlaws, when he fell just two runs short of a century.

The Spitfires will be looking to bounce back from their second defeat to the Foxes and put some pressure back on their title rivals.

Like the Foxes, they will be confident of picking up four points against rock-bottom Surrey Lions.

Before that they face a Northamptonshire Steelbacks side still reeling from conceding 344 runs to Gloucestershire Gladiators in an 83-run defeat.

The Lions lost their eighth game in nine against Yorkshire Phoenix and require maximum points from their forthcoming matches with the Spitfires and the Gladiators if they are to avoid an immediate drop to the Second Division.

The Phoenix will be looking to further ease their relegation fears, with Ryan Sidebottom showing some good form, with a win over the Outlaws, who are one place above them in fifth.

● ROYALS' PROMOTION BID TAKES FLIGHT

Worcestershire Royals, with help from Andy Bichel, will hope to take a step closer to promotion as they take on bottom side Essex Eagles in the Norwich Union League Division Two.

The Royals hold top spot, having won eight of their 10 games, but know with Hampshire Hawks, Durham Dynamos and Glamorgan Dragons hot on their heels, a top-three spot is not yet assured.

Emphatic victories by Graeme Hick's side in their last two games - they chased 275 from 42.2 overs to beat the Dynamos and crushed Lancashire Lightning by 109 runs - suggest they will have little trouble against an Eagles side who have won once all season.

The second-placed Hawks, just two points behind the Royals with a game in hand, face a tough couple of games, firstly with the visit of the Dragons, who are keen to keep their promotion hopes on track. The Welshmen scored a comprehensive 46-run win over the Lightning in their last fixture to move within four points of third place and with two games in hand are very much a threat.

The Hawks then travel to the Riverside for a showdown with the Dynamos, where they will be trying to match their 64-run victory over Jon Lewis' side in June. For the Dynamos, the game comes just two days after their encounter with sixth-placed Derbyshire Scorpions.

Elsewhere in the Second Division, struggling Middlesex Crusaders and Lancashire Lightning will look to give their one-day Norwich Union League campaigns a lift when they meet at Lord's.

NORTHANTS STEELBACKS versus KENT SPITFIRES

MATCH PREVIEW

Matthew Fleming's Kent Spitfires face a test of their Norwich Union League Division One title credentials as they travel to Northampton to face Northamptonshire Steelbacks.

The Spitfires may well have already surrendered the league crown to Leicestershire Foxes after missing out by 14 runs to their main title rivals in their last game.

The defeat allowed the Foxes to open up an eight-point lead at the top and with a game in hand, the feeling must be that only a dramatic slip-up from Vince Wells' so-far unbeaten team will give the Spitfires a reprieve.

However, Fleming's side have the talent at their disposal to bounce back to winning ways against the struggling Steelbacks.

All-rounders Mark Ealham and Andrew Symonds both bowled economically against the Foxes and the Spitfires are also in good form with the bat.

Wicketkeeper Paul Nixon and Fleming, coming in at six and eight respectively, offer the Spitfires great depth and David Ripley's team will face a tough challenge.

THE DUCKWORTH/LEWIS SYSTEM

If matches are rain-affected the Duckworth Lewis system is used to reset targets. The system is based on what percentage of its resources (overs and wickets) a team have left. With 50 overs left and 10 wickets remaining, a team has 100 per cent of its resources left. The table shows the percentage of resources at other stages in the innings.

The procedure for working out targets is as follows:

1) For each innings: Use the table to calculate the resource percentage lost by the interruption and therefore calculate the resource percentage still available.

2) If team 2 have less resources available than team 1, calculate the ratio of the resources available to both teams. Team 2's revised target is obtained by scaling down team 1's score by this ratio.

3) If team 2 have more resources available than team 1, calculate the amount by which team 2's resources exceeds team 1's.

Work this out as a percentage of 225 (the average 50-over score in ECB matches and one-day internationals). This gives the extra runs to add to team score to give team 2's target.

HOW THE NORWICH UNION LEAGUE WORKS

The Norwich Union League operates on a three-up, three-down basis with the top three finishers in Division Two replacing the bottom three in Division One. Four points are awarded for a win, while teams will take two points each if matches are tied or the weather intervenes before the required number of overs have been completed and there is no result.

Matches will start at 1pm and end at 7.10pm with 45 overs per side, although all fixtures will begin 30 minutes earlier in September. Floodlit games will start at 4.10pm. The free-hit rule for no-balls applies to front-foot no-balls only. A batsman cannot be

dismissed from the bowler's next delivery after such an infringement.

This season teams will face penalties for slow over rates. In the opinion of the umpire there are still overs to be bowled at the cut-off point then six runs will be added to the batting team for every over left to be bowled. If at cut-off time there are still four overs left to be bowled then 24 runs will be added to the batting team's score. The batting team will then go on and finish their overs. These will appear as penalty runs on the scorecard. If this takes the batting team over the target required then the match will finish at that point.
